



Rooftop Bird Boxes

In August 2009 two bird boxes were added to the Yurrah rooftop backyard. One bird box was made specially for small parrots and the other for kookaburras. The boxes were made by *Hollow Log Homes*.

Almost as soon as they were installed a curious pair of Rosellas moved into the small parrot box, making a colourful addition to the space.

A pair of kookaburras moved into their home in early October 2009 and to our delight laid 3 eggs. We were able to carefully get close enough to photograph the chicks as they grew.

In late November we discovered one of the birds was missing; unfortunately only two survived to adulthood. In early December the two kookaburras were grown up enough to leave the nest.
